

June 9, 2009

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 A.M. on June 9, 2009 with members Dale Long, Jim Schmidt, Jason Melcher, Dennis Weeldreyer and David Gillespie present. The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. The Deputy Auditor was clerk of the Board.

A motion by Weeldreyer and seconded by Melcher that the minutes of June 2, 2009 be approved. Motion carried.
