

POLL WORKERS NEEDED

Lincoln County is looking for people interested in being a Poll worker for the Primary Election (**June 8, 2010**) and General Election (**November 2, 2010**).

Duties of a Poll worker:

- ❖ Spend 12 to 14 hours at the voting precinct you are assigned to.
- ❖ Assist in preparing the precinct for voting
- ❖ Greet voters and process them for voting
- ❖ Process ballots, forms and other election requirements with accuracy
- ❖ Assist with closing the polls and preparation of returning voted ballots to the Lincoln County Auditor's Office for counting.

Poll workers are encouraged to attend a 1 – 2 hour Election School prior to each election. You will be paid a flat rate plus mileage for attending the school.

Poll workers are paid a flat rate for working on Election Day.
