



Gerhard & Larry Sweeter Memorial Beef & Swine Loan



The Gerhard & Larry Sweeter Memorial Livestock Loan is open to all Lincoln County 4-H members for the purpose of purchasing beef or swine for their 4-H project. The loan will be awarded to one or more 4-H members who apply to the Lincoln County 4-H Leaders Association and are selected by a committee appointed by the Leaders Association. The amount awarded will be determined by the leaders not to exceed the actual cost of the livestock. The money will be awarded in the fall and paid to the 4-H member upon receipt of the bill of sale.

Applicants must agree to show the animal at the Lincoln County Achievement Days and must repay the total amount of the loan (with no interest chard) by Oct. 1 of the following year. In the event of a death loss, the applicant will still be liable for repayment of the loan. In the event that payment is not received by the due date, cost recovery steps will be taken.

In the event that no applications are received during the application period or not all of the funds are expended, the memorial funds will be place on interest by the Lincoln County 4-H Leaders Association with the earned interest added to the loan program.

Completed applications are due by Dec. 1 to the Extension Office.
